









Steps to register your Phone's Bluetooth MAC Address

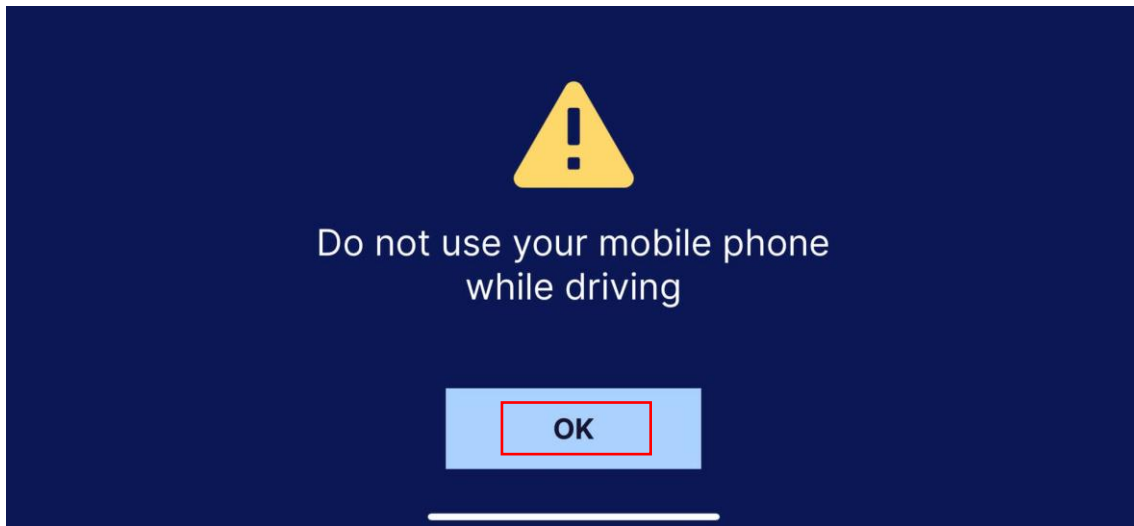

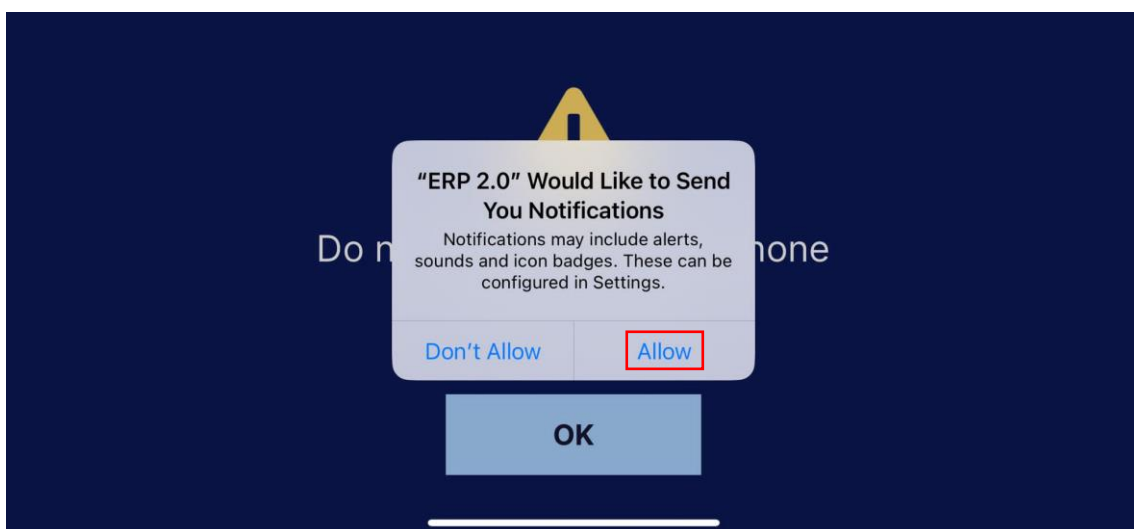
Steps to pair your Phone with OBU using ERP 2.0 Mobile Application



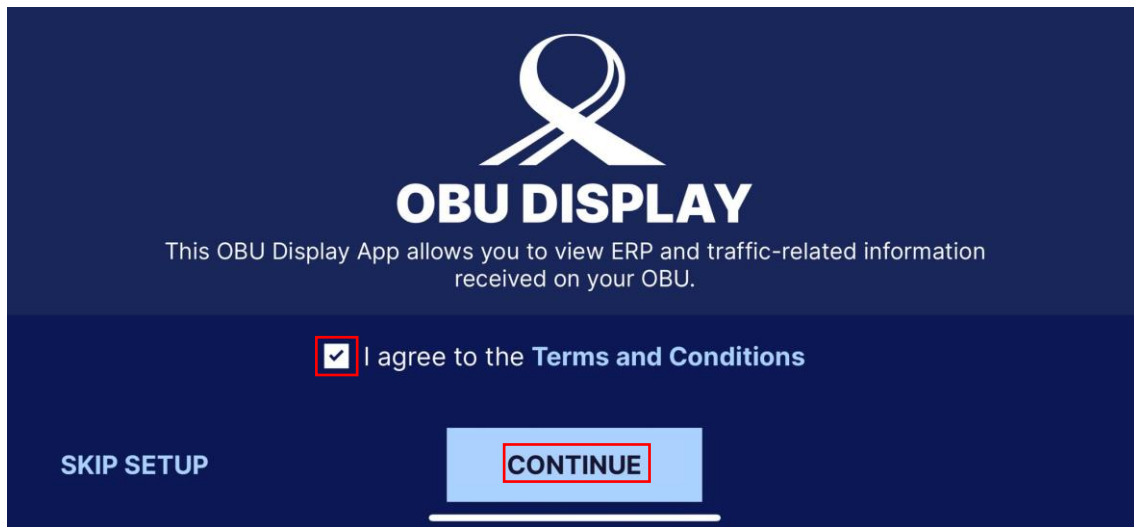
1. Launch "ERP 2.0" mobile application



2. Acknowledge Caution message while driving



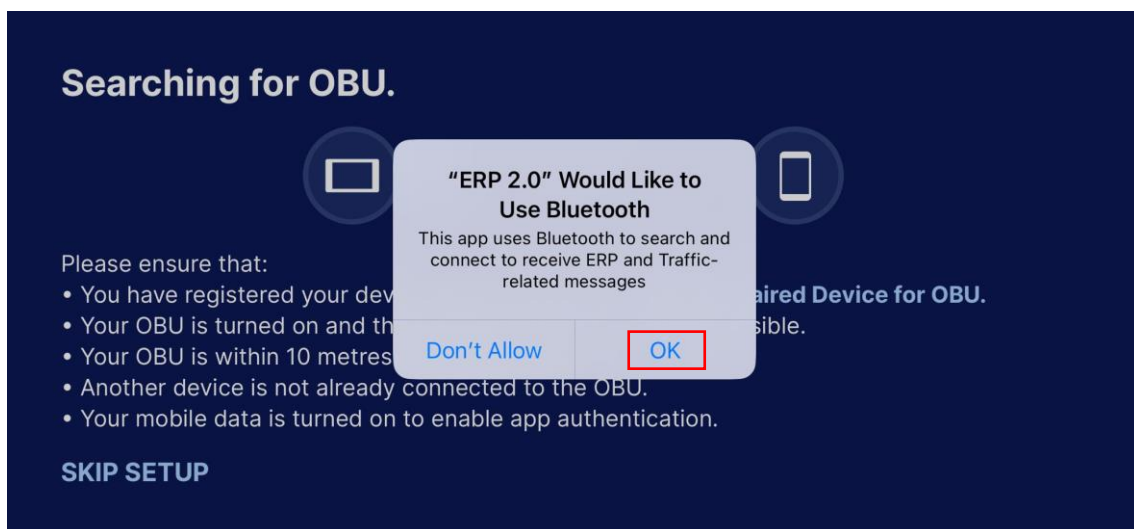
3. Allow "ERP 2.0" to send you Notifications



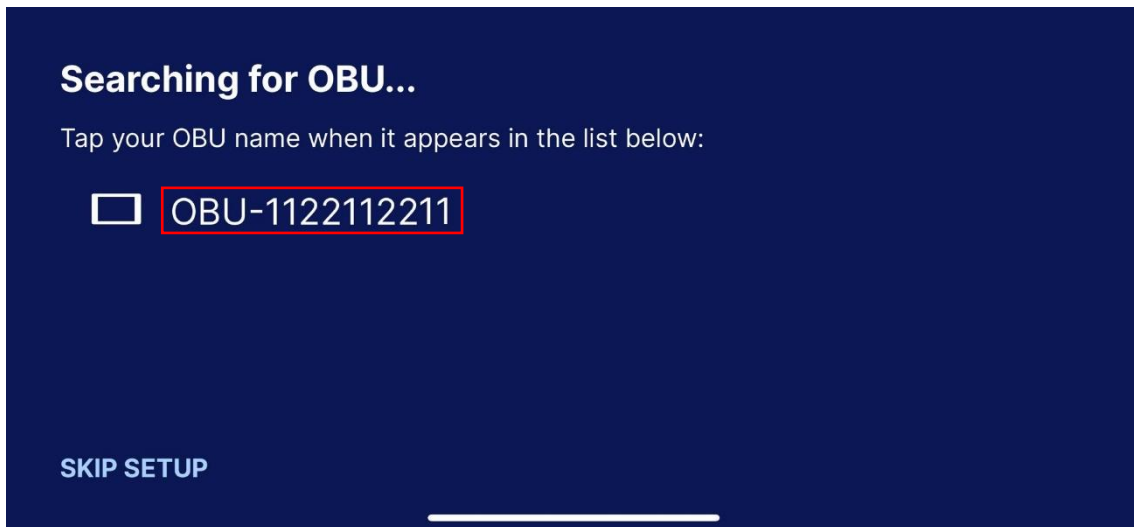
4. Agree to the Terms and Conditions to continue



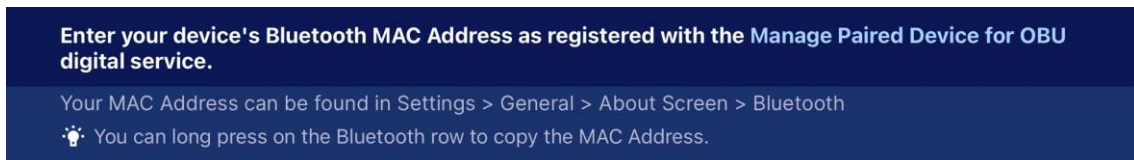
5. Allow "ERP 2.0" to access your OBU data



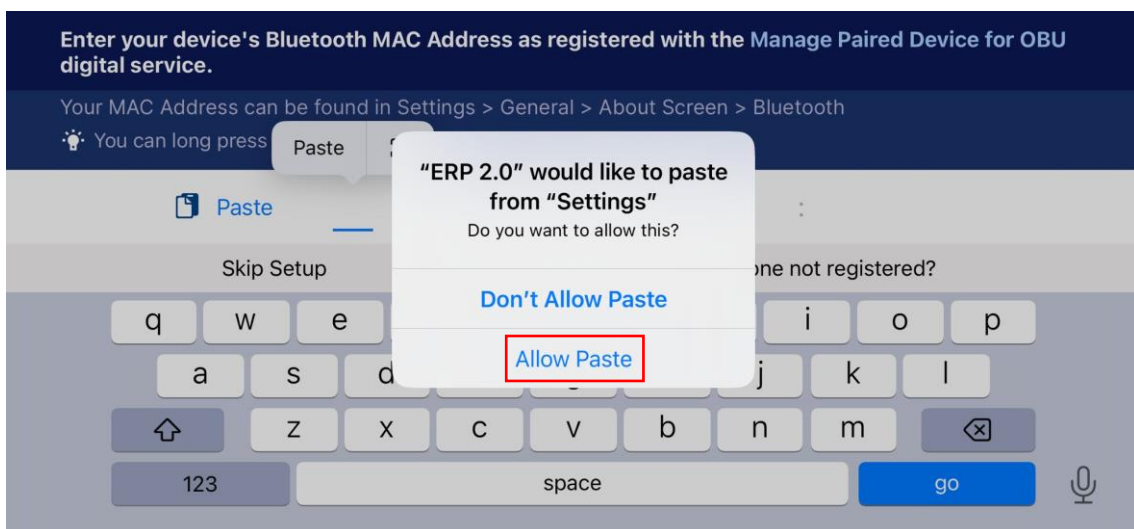
6. Allow "ERP 2.0" to use Bluetooth to search for your OBU



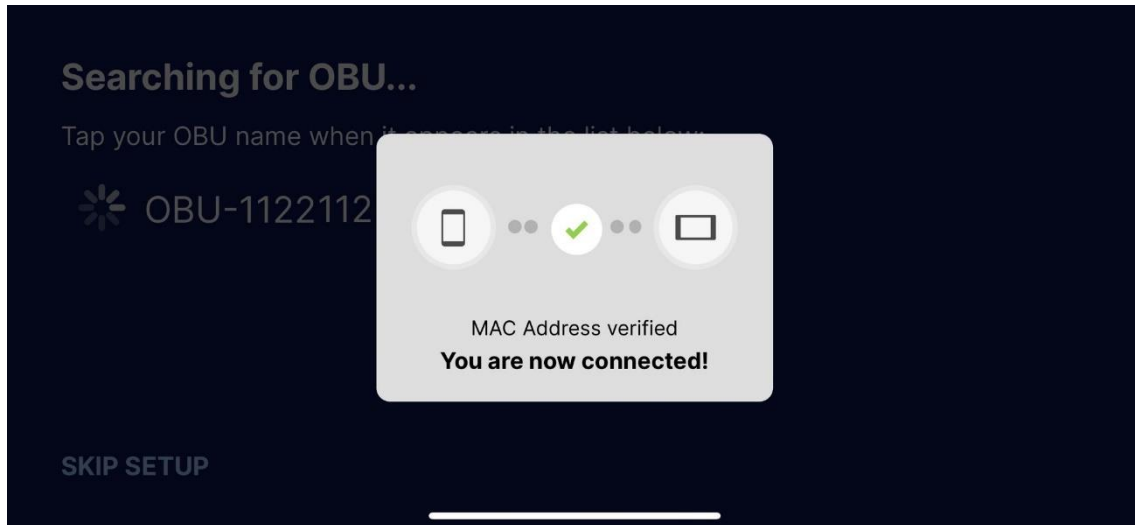
7. Tap on your OBU to pair (Ignore the Bluetooth passkey/pairing code)



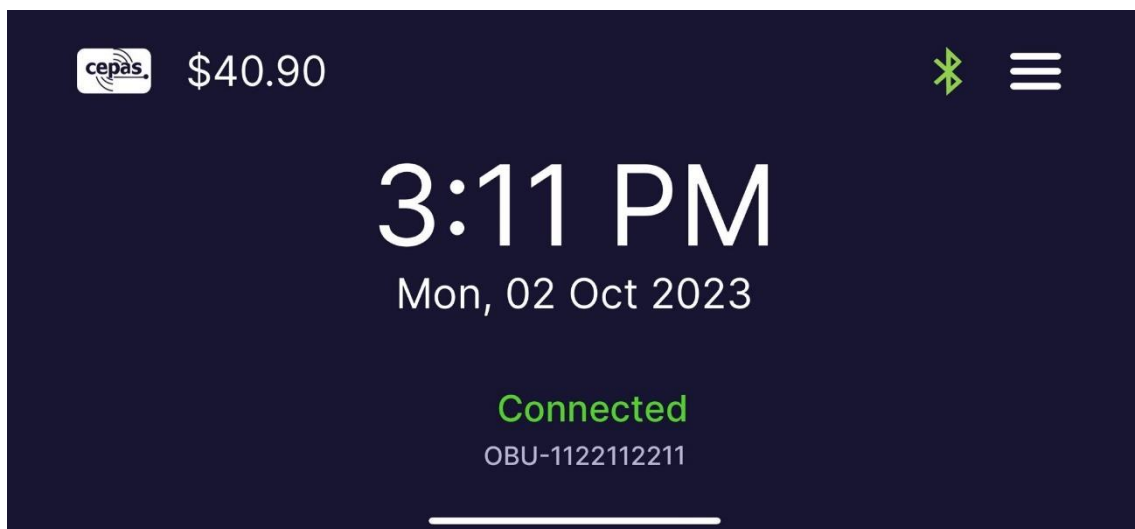
8. Copy and paste your registered Bluetooth MAC Address

Common error codes encountered during pairing:

Error Code	Description	Actions
1002	Bluetooth access denied	Only 1 phone can pair with the OBU at a time. Ensure that the OBU is not paired with another device.
2004	OBU access permission denied	Users need to allow the App to access OBU data. Please refer to Step 5 to pair your Phone with OBU again.
2010	App does not have OBU information	- Users need to register their Phone's Bluetooth MAC address before pairing with OBU. Please refer to the "Steps to register your Phone's Bluetooth MAC Address". OR - Please allow approximately 45 minutes after registering your Bluetooth MAC address before pairing with OBU.
