



Submission of foreign-registered vehicle photographs in VEP/Autopass card application and update vehicle road tax and insurance validity application

All foreign-registered vehicles in Singapore must have their vehicle registration number plate prominently displayed at the front and back of all vehicles, so that vehicles can be easily identified for regulation, enforcement, and emergency purposes.

Vehicle license plates must display the vehicle registration number clearly as approved by the vehicle country-of-registration's authority, where all the letters and digits can be easily seen for application approval. The vehicle registration number shall be in Arabic numerals and Latin characters, as reflected accordingly in the vehicle documents and notarised translations (if relevant) provided to LTA.
