

APPLICATION FOR DEREGISTRATION OF A VEHICLE AND GRANT OF PARF / COE REBATE(S)

This form is only for applicants who are not eligible for Singpass and have to carry out the transaction at LTA Customer Service Centre.

Note: - a) A vehicle can be disposed of for deregistration at an LTA-authorised scrapyard or Export Processing Zone (EPZ), or by exporting out of Singapore. You can dispose of the vehicle yourself or engage the services of a CaseTrust-SVTA accredited motor dealer for greater assurance. For more details on the CaseTrust-SVTA accreditation scheme, please visit www.CaseTrust.org.sg.			
b) Once a deregistration application is approved, a letter will be issued by LTA to the last registered owner informing him/ her of the vehicle's deregistration and details of any PARF/ COE rebate(s), which may be granted, or arrears of road tax/ late renewal fees(s), if any. Road tax arrears/late renewal fees can be paid at AXS (m-station/e-Station/kiosk) or online at https://onemotoring.lta.gov.sg (from 1AM to midnight).			
c) For vehicles stored in an LTA-authorised EPZ, the maximum storage period allowed is 12 months from the vehicles' date of deregistration, unless otherwise approved by the LTA. Disposal documents must be submitted to LTA through the EPZ operators not more than 14 days after the vehicles had exited an EPZ or by the expiry of their storage period, whichever is earlier.			
 d) Upon deregistration, any remaining road tax, OPC cash rebates of the vehicle, if granted, will be made to the last registered owner. No application is necessary. 			
e) Please liaise with your financial institution to settle any outstanding financing on your vehicle before applying for deregistration of the vehicle.

*I / We *am / are applying to deregister *my / our vehicle and, where applicable, be granted the PARF/COE rebate(s) in respect of the deregistered vehicle.			
*I/ We understand that *my / our application is subject but not limited to the following conditions (where applicable):- (a) Application for deregistration of a vehicle cannot be backdated and it must be done before its road tax or lay up/road tax exemption period expires. Otherwise, any arrears of road tax and late renewal fee(s) (where applicable) must be settled in full prior to the vehicle's deregistration application being considered by the Registrar; (b) If *I / we wish to retain the registration number of this vehicle for a new or existing vehicle to be registered in *my / our name, *I / we will apply to retain the			
registration number <u>before</u> deregistering the vehicle by completing the prescribed form and submitting it together with the registration number retention fee, and this application form; (c) Once a vehicle is deregistered, it cannot be re-registered in Singapore. It is an offence for anyone to keep or use a deregistered vehicle. A deregistered			
vehicle can only be kept at an LTA-authorised EPZ or an area approved by the Registrar; (d) The vehicle cannot be parked or driven on the road or in a public place including HDB estates, after it has been deregistered. A general licence cannot be			
used on a deregistered vehicle; (e) *I / We must show proof to the Registrar's satisfaction either at the time of registration of *my / our new vehicle or within a month of the old vehicle's deregistration date, whichever is earlier, or any earlier date which the Registrar may, in his discretion require, that the old vehicle has been scrapped at an LTA-authorised scrapyard, temporarily stored in an LTA-authorised EPZ, or exported permanently out of Singapore

- Original* NRIC (Singaporeans and Singapore PRs) or Employment / Immigration pass card issued by MOM or ICA (Foreigners) of the registered owner, or in the case of a company vehicle, the original* NRIC(s) (Singaporeans and Singapore PRs) or Employment / Immigration pass card issued by MOM or ICA (Foreigners) of Director(s)/Soleproprietor/Partner(s) whose name(s) is/are listed in the ACRA printout, or a representative who is authorised, in writing, by the named Director(s)/ Partner(s) to sign Form D01 on behalf of the company.

CONDITIONS FOR GRANTING OF PREFERENTIAL ADDITIONAL REGISTRATION FEE (PARF) AND/OR CERTIFICATE OF ENTITLEMENT (COE) REBATE(S)

PARF rebate

PARF rebates are calculated based on the age of the vehicle at deregistration and the actual ARF paid. Where applicable, the following PARF rebate amount will apply.

Age of PARF-eligible Vehicle at Deregistration	PARF Rebate (for vehicles registered with COEs obtained before the second COE bidding exercise in February 2023, or taxis/COE-exempted vehicles registered before 15 February 2023)	PARF Rebate (for vehicles registered with COEs obtained from the second COE bidding exercise in February 2023 onwards, or taxis/COE-exempted vehicles registered on or after 15 February 2023)
Not exceeding 5 years	75% of ARF Paid*	75% of ARF Paid* or \$60,000 (whichever is lower)
Above 5 years but not exceeding 6 years	70% of ARF Paid*	70% of ARF Paid* or \$60,000 (whichever is lower)
Above 6 years but not exceeding 7 years	65% of ARF Paid*	65% of ARF Paid* or \$60,000 (whichever is lower)
Above 7 years but not exceeding 8 years	60% of ARF Paid*	60% of ARF Paid* or \$60,000 (whichever is lower)
Above 8 years but not exceeding 9 years	55% of ARF Paid*	55% of ARF Paid* or \$60,000 (whichever is lower)
Above 9 years but not exceeding 10 years	50% of ARF Paid*	50% of ARF Paid* or \$60,000 (whichever is lower)
Above 10 years	Nil	Nil

*For ARF-paid cars and taxis that have enjoyed tax incentives such as the Green Vehicle Rebate, Off-Peak Car Rebate Carbon Emissions-Based Vehicle Scheme (CEVS) Rebate or Vehicular Emissions Scheme (VES) Rebate, the calculation of the PARF rebate will be based on the net ARF, i.e. ARF less rebate enjoyed.

- ARF-paid cars must not be more than 10 years old at the time of its deregistration. The age of the car is calculated based on the date of its original registration (locally or overseas, whichever is earlier). For example, if a car was registered on 23 October 2010, it is deemed to be 10 years old on 22 October 2020. This same car shall be deemed to be 5 years old on 22 October 2015. To be eligible for PARF rebate, the car must be deregistered on or before 22 October 2020.
- PARF rebates are applicable to taxis which are deregistered by their statutory lifespan expiry. c)
- d) The vehicle must be licensed at all times, and was not or will not be temporarily unlicensed.
- e) The vehicle must have been new at the time of its registration in Singapore or an imported used car that was registered in Singapore on or after 1 September 2007.

COE rebate

- If a vehicle is deregistered before the expiry of its COE, the COE rebate will be granted based on the Quota Premium (QP) or the Prevailing Quota Premium (PQP) paid, pro-rated to the number of months and days remaining on the vehicle's COE. For a vehicle registered using Category E (Open Category) COE, the COE rebate granted will be pro-rated to the number of months and days remaining on the QP Paid of either the Category E or its corresponding category from the same tender exercise, whichever is lower.
- If a vehicle is deregistered within 2 years of its registration for the purpose of export, the COE rebate will be capped at 80% of the QP paid upon registration. For a vehicle registered using Category E (Open Category) COE, the COE rebate granted will be capped at 80% of the Category E QP or the QP of its corresponding category from the same tender exercise, whichever is lower.

Utilisation of PARF/COE rebate(s)

- The car must be scrapped at an LTA-authorised scrappard, temporarily stored in an LTA-authorised EPZ or permanently exported before the PARF and/or COE rebate can be used. If the car is exported, one or more of the following original documents, as applicable, must be submitted to the Registrar:

 i) Foreign re-registration documents; or

 - ii) Export documents (e.g. duly endorsed Singapore Customs Cargo Clearance Permit and non-negotiable copy of Bill of Lading from shipping company (if applicable)).
- The PARF and COE rebate(s) will be null and void if the disposal document(s) of the vehicle is (are) found to be invalid in any way or manner.
- The PARF and COE rebate(s) have a validity period of 12 months from the date of the vehicle's deregistration and must be utilised within the validity period. c)
- The PARF rebate can be used to offset the Registration Fee (RF), Additional Registration Fee (ARF), QP, Used Car Surcharge, CEVS Surcharge or VES Surcharge payable for the registration of a car in the owner's name.
- The COE rebate can be used to offset the RF, ARF, QP, Used Car Surcharge, CEVS Surcharge or VES Surcharge payable for the registration of a vehicle in the owner's name or the PQP payable for revalidating the COE of a vehicle that is currently registered in the owner's name. e)
- f) The PARF and COE rebate(s) may be transferred together or separately to a third party. A fee of S\$20 is payable for the transfer of each rebate. Alternatively, you may apply to encash the PARF and/ or COE rebate(s).
- The granting of rebate and the determination of the rebate amount is subject to the Registrar's discretion in addition to an applicant complying with the above minimum requirements.

Consent to the collection, use and disclosure of personal data
