Reminder – Eligibility Criteria for Early Turnover Scheme (ETS)

We would like to remind motor dealers again of the eligibility criteria for the ETS as stated in the **ANNEX** of this circular.

In particular, please note that to be eligible for the ETS, the existing vehicle, at the point of deregistration:

- must be under the permanent ownership of the registered owner who will be registering the replacement vehicle under the ETS, and
- must be deregistered with at least 1 day of remaining COE or 20-year lifespan. Any transfer of ownership, if required, must be effected before the existing vehicle is deregistered (including auto deregistration due to COE expiry, lifespan expiry, etc.).

Eligibility Criteria for the Early Turnover Scheme

To be eligible for the scheme, the following criteria must be met:

(I) The existing vehicle must be:

- A Cat C vehicle and not COE-exempted;
- Propelled by diesel, diesel-Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) or diesel-electric;
- Under the permanent ownership of the registered owner;
- Registered between 1 January 2001 and 30 September 2006, and deregistered from 1 August 2017 to 31 July 2019;
- Properly disposed of (i.e. scrapped or exported and COE rebate, if any, successfully granted) before registration of the replacement vehicle; and
- Have at least one day of COE life remaining **or** at least one day of its 20-year lifespan remaining, at the point of deregistration.

(II) The replacement vehicle must be:

- A Cat C vehicle and not COE-exempted. The replacement Cat C vehicle can be of any type, e.g. an existing Light Goods Vehicle (LGV) can be replaced with a Heavy Goods Vehicle (HGV). However, the registered owner must fulfil the registration conditions of the replacement vehicle, such as obtaining LTA's prior approval for the registration of a private hire bus, etc;
- Registered in the name of the last registered owner of the existing vehicle¹;
- Registered within 1 month from the date of deregistration of the existing vehicle. For example, if the existing vehicle is deregistered on 15 November 2018, the replacement vehicle must be registered by 14 December 2018. As the scheme ends on 31 July 2019, the last day to deregister is 31 July 2019 and its replacement vehicle must be registered by 30 August 2019.
- Propelled by any of the following:
