Additional Petrol Duty Rebates for Individual Owners of Smaller Motorcycles to be Disbursed from May 2021

I refer to our press release and circular (Ref: VRL/04/2021) dated 16 February 2021 on the road tax rebate for petrol and petrol-hybrid vehicles and the additional Petrol Duty Rebates (PDR) for individual owners of petrol and petrol-hybrid motorcycles of up to 400cc to ease the transition towards higher petrol duties.

2. The total amount of rebates for motorcycles are as shown in the table below.

Type of Vehicle Using Petrol	Amount of Rebates
Motorcycles	<p>60% road tax rebate for one year¹; and</p> <p>Additional PDR of \$80 for individual owners of motorcycles registered as at the close of 16 February 2021 with engine capacity of 200cc and below, and \$50 for individual owners of motorcycles registered as at the close of 16 February 2021 with engine capacity of 201 – 400cc</p>

3. Individual owners of registered petrol and petrol-hybrid motorcycles/scooters of up to 400cc as at the close of 16 February 2021 (i.e. 0000 hrs of 17 February 2021) will receive the additional PDR. Individual owners with more than one registered motorcycle/scooter of up to 400cc will be entitled to one pay-out, whichever is higher.

¹ Owners who are leasing out their motorcycles are urged to pass on the rebates to their lessees, who are incurring higher petrol costs.

4. LTA will disburse the additional PDR to eligible individual owners of petrol and petrol-hybrid motorcycles with engine capacity of up to 400cc progressively from mid-May, through GIRO or PayNow (NRIC). No application is required. Owners will be notified via SMS when the additional PDR has been credited to their bank accounts.

5. Individual motorcycle owners who wish to receive the additional PDR via GIRO should ensure that they update their bank account details on LTA's website at go.gov.sg/ltaupdate (or via the attached QR code) by 15 May 2021.
