Certificate of Entitlement (COE) Renewal via LTALink System using Fast And Secured Transfers (FAST)

Arising from feedback received, LTA has implemented the COE renewal function in the LTALink System.

With effect from 11 July 2021, Electronic Service Agents (ESAs) can **renew the COE of the vehicles under their temporary ownership** via the LTALink System (go to Ownership \rightarrow COE renewal \rightarrow Renew COE) with payment of the Prevailing Quota Premium and relevant taxes/fees made using FAST. At the same time, ESAs may also renew the vehicle's road tax, together with the COE renewal, if the vehicle's road tax has expired or will be expiring within the next 7 days and the vehicle has fulfilled all road tax renewal prerequisites.

As FAST deducts funds instantly, ESAs should make sure that they have sufficient funds in their bank accounts before performing transactions including COE renewals and making payments in the LTALink System. This will help avoid incurring an administrative fee, which may be imposed for each unsuccessful FAST deduction.

You may refer to Annex A for the User Guide for ESAs regarding the FAST service.

To renew the COE of a vehicle that is under <u>permanent</u> vehicle ownership, the owner may use the COE renewal digital service on the OneMotoring portal (go to *onemotoring.lta.gov.sg > Digital Services > Renew COE*) with payment made using **SGQR PayNow or eNETs Debit (internet banking).**
