IMPLEMENTATION OF ON-BOARD UNIT FOR VEHICLES (NON-MOTORCYCLES / SCOOTERS) REGISTERED IN SINGAPORE

- 1. The Land Transport Authority (LTA) will be replacing the existing Electronic Road Pricing (ERP) system with the ERP 2.0 system that uses Global Navigation Satellite System (GNSS) technology. With that, the existing In-Vehicle Unit (IU) will be replaced with the new On-Board Unit (OBU).
- 2. LTA will update the pre-registration procedure for new and imported used vehicles (non-motorcycles/scooters)¹ in Singapore to facilitate OBU installation. We are working closely with various industry stakeholders to familiarise them with the new procedure before implementation.
- 3. With effect from 1 November 2024, any motor dealer, distributor, or importer who wishes to register any make and model of vehicles (non-motorcycles/scooters) with LTA in Singapore, is required to submit an OBU Compliance Form, and attach the relevant declaration or test report to LTA for verification. Please refer to Appendix A for the OBU Compliance Form, the template for submitting declaration / test report, as well as details of the technical requirements for OBU installation in vehicles (non-motorcycles/scooters). The application shall be sent to the email address (LTA_OBU_LNO@lta.gov.sg) which shall also be used for subsequent correspondences with LTA.
- 4. For new and imported used motorcycles/scooters, this pre-registration procedure will take effect from 15 May 2024, as announced in an industry circular issued by LTA in February 2024.²

¹ It shall be mandatory for all Singapore-registered vehicles to install the new OBU following the end of the OBU installation exercise, except for: (i) Singapore-registered vehicles that are not allowed to travel on mainland public roads such as tractors, locomotives, construction equipment; (ii) vehicles on Restricted Use Scheme such as airport vehicles, port vehicles, Pulau Ubin vehicles, vehicles used in offshore islands only, vehicles on laid-up status, and vehicles under the Keeping Scheme; (iii) non-mechanically propelled vehicles such as trailers; and (iv) classic/vintage vehicles as they are more sparingly used and subject to usage restrictions.

- 5. A Letter of No Objection (LNO) will be issued by LTA to the applicant if the submitted documents and information are found to be in order. Please note that you will be required to submit the LNO, as part of your vehicle approval application for any new and imported used vehicles (non-motorcycles/scooters), in the Vehicle Inspection and Type Approval System (VITAS) from 1 November 2024 onwards.
- 6. If the relevant vehicle does not present a permanent 12V / 24V power supply that can be used for OBU installation, please contact LTA, who will then advise the applicant on an interim solution.




Figure 1: Procedure to obtain LNO

- 7. An overview of the procedure for obtaining the LNO is shown in **Figure 1** below.

<u>Appendix B - Frequently Asked Questions on the New Pre-Registration Approval</u> Procedure for Vehicles (Non-Motorcycles/Scooters)

1. Will my vehicle type-approval for non-motorcycles/scooters be affected in the meantime if I do not submit any OBU Compliance Form before 1 November 2024?

The new pre-registration approval procedure for vehicles (non-motorcycles/scooters) will only take effect from 1 November 2024. But we strongly encourage all motor dealers, distributors, or importers to start adopting and familiarising themselves with this new procedure in the meantime so that you can be ready with the submission by the time your new and imported used vehicles (non-motorcycles/scooters) needs to undergo type-approval on/from 1 November 2024.

2. How fast can I expect to receive the Letter of No Objection after I submit my application?

This depends on the complexity of the application and whether the supporting documents are properly submitted, and all requirements are met. We suggest all motor dealers, distributors, or importers to set aside at least 3 weeks for the application to be processed.

3. What if I am unable to meet the permanent 12V / 24V power supply requirement in the OBU Compliance Form?
