Two-Year Trial to Suspend Vehicle Parking Certificate (VPC) Requirement for Trailers from 6 February 2026

In consultation with the Singapore Transport Association, LTA will suspend the VPC requirement for trailers (including container trailers, low loaders and flat-bed trailers) for a trial period of 2 years from 6 February 2026 to 5 February 2028. This trial is part of LTA's review of the VPC scheme across all heavy vehicle categories.

During the trial period, trailers will not be required to have a valid VPC for the following transactions:

1. New Vehicle Registration
2. Transfer of Vehicle Ownership
3. Renewal of Road Tax

In addition, Heavy Vehicle Park Operators will not be able to issue VPCs for your licensed trailer parking lots.

No refunds will be made for the \$6 fee paid for each VPC issued to trailers prior to 6 February 2026. Trailer owners who have paid for season parking can continue to park at their respective Heavy Vehicle Park (HVPs).

HVP Operators are encouraged to review the utilisation of your licensed parking lots and convert unused licensed trailer parking lots to licensed heavy vehicle parking lots to free up more parking lots for heavy vehicles.

If you wish to convert unused licensed trailer parking lots to licensed heavy vehicle parking lots (on a one-for-one ratio), please apply to LTA for review via LTA's OneMotoring website > Login using Singpass for Businesses > HV Park > Maintain HV Park Licence > Convert Licence.
